

2014 Canadian Melges 24 Class Association Report

The Canadian Melges 24 Class Association (CMCA) was formed in March 2013 with growing fleets in Ontario and British Columbia (BC). Previous to this, the few Canadian boats belonged to the well established USMCA. The Canadian regions continue to foster strong ties with their USMCA counterparts to optimize regatta attendance and minimize scheduling conflicts.

Canada's full membership in IMCA has grown to 32 in 2014 from only 13 last year. We have well established fleets in Toronto and Victoria with other boats in outlying areas who travel to local events. We are keen that these boats in places like Vancouver and Kelowna will attract more Melges 24's to establish more viable local fleets.

In addition to racing numerous local regattas in 2014 many Canadian boats travelled to US regattas including Key West Regatta, Miami Sailing Week, Charleston Race Week and Seattle NOOD. The BC region played host to a very successful [Canadian National Championship](#) with a 30 boat fleet racing for 3 days of solid breeze off the Victoria waterfront.

2015 Canadian Nationals will take place in Ontario, the venue to be determined at CMCA AGM in November.
