Subject: Proposed Motions, IMCA AGM 2013

Dear Executive Committee, National Class Officers, IMCA Professionals and Builders,

The Melges24 Italian Class Association is glad to submit the following motions to your consideration:

Proposal #1

IMCA EVENT MANAGEMENT REQUIREMENTS
A: SHORE FACILITIES

23. INCIDENTALS

- Signage - All of the above facilities are to be well signed except the Results office.
- First Aid facilities - These shall be provided and clearly sign posted and indicated on the event site plan.
One ambulance will be available at the venue from one hour before the first start up to the end of daily races.
- Site Plan - A detailed site plan shall be provided including all the above facilities plus the racing areas out to sea. It shall be printed in the event programme. Large scale prints of same shall be located in the Regatta Secretariat & Beach Office and on the General Notice Boards.

As a large number of sailors is involved in main regattas, improving a safety support can strongly reduce consequences in case of injuries during events.

Proposal #2

CHAMPIONSHIP RULES

all points # 16:

Number of Races

16 The championship shall comprise either:

10 ~~or 12~~ races of which the score of one may be discarded if 6 or more races are completed. If less than 5 races are sailed the Trophy shall not be awarded.

OR:

When the fleet is split a ~~10 12~~ race series with 2 races per day for the first three days to provide a gold and silver fleet and then 2 races per day for the remaining ~~2 3~~ days for the championship. One race may be discarded from the first six races and then subsequently one discarded from the overall series. If less than 5 races are sailed the Trophy shall not be awarded.

A spare day shall not be scheduled for the last day of the regatta series.

MEASUREMENT AND EQUIPMENT INSPECTION REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURES

INSPECTION FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT TO BE SUPPLIED BY THE EVENT ORGANISERS:

add:

- **Original "IMCA marked" set of foils and keel templates as supplied by the organizers NCA. All National Class Associations may require to buy a complete set of foils/keel templates to IMCA in order to support competitors before the event and organizers at the venue.**

All NCAs must be allowed to supply that control service to associates and clubs.
