●No Owner informed me directly about problems with the Melges24, I assume that there has not been any big issues this Year.

●Last AGM in Mailand we published the drawings for the rudder gudgeons, some German teams have build some. The price was around 400 € for a complete set. This price was for one single set, so if more sets are produced the price can drop significantly. The teams are satisfied with the performance until now.

●**Worlds 2015 Middelfart, Denmark**

●Sail measurements at the Worlds in Middelfart was at some times very crowded. The time-slots which had been given to the teams where not really respected. Mostly because some crews came back to sort some problems. Sometimes there where up to 4 crews in the tent to measure sails and get stamps etc. Because of that crowded environment, it was hard to follow which sails belonged to each team. For example, I got two stamps in my Jib.

●It is advised to have a helper sitting in front of the measurment-area to help guiding the teams. He should make a precheck if every sail is there, should explain the procedure and should check that only two teams are in the area.

●Its very important that the measurement procedure is at a professional mood and speed. Mistakes here will lead to a bad feeling at the participating teams.
