Swiss National Class Report 2013

2013 the Swiss Melges 24 Class Association SMCA counts 8 active sailing boats. On the membership list we actually have 8 full and 1 associate memberships. Further 10 boats are registered in Switzerland but have not raced on national or international level. This boats and owners are not members of the national class association SMCA.

All the boats are located all over Switzerland, mainly in the german speaking parts, lake constance, lake zurich and lake thun. We also have active members in the italian speaking part of switzerland

Most of the active sailing teams took part at the Italian Act Series 2013 (former Volvo Cup) for partly or full participation. For the swiss sailors, the Italian circuit is still a good and attractive, while near opportunity to sail in strong fleets. Some of the swiss teams were following additionally some events within the Melges 24 European Sailing Series.

The Swiss Open 2013 has been held from October 11th – 13th in Luino, in combination with the „Coppa Lino Favini“ and Italian Act Nr. 5. The event saw an pleasant entry of 23 boats from 8 different Nations. Team „Blu Moon“ (Franco Rossini SUI) with helmsman Flavio Favini have been crowned Swiss Open Champions.

The General Meeting of the SMCA decided to again take the offer from the the Yachtclub AVAV in Lunio (Italy) to combine the Swiss Open Championships 2014 together with the Coppa Lino Favini from Oktober 10th – 12th.
