Notice of Race (NoR)

The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The applying prescriptions of the Scandinavian Sailing Association and the Danish Sailing Association will be incorporated into the sailing instructions.
- 1.3 The following other documents will apply:
 - Statutes for Danish Championships in Sailing.
 - Total weight of the crew is not to exceed 375 kg.
 - All boats shall have bow numbers installed according to International Melges 24 class rules.
- 1.4 The Racing Rules are changed as follows:
 - All competitors shall wear personal flotation devices while racing, except for brief periods while changing or adjusting clothing. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal floatation devices. This changes rule 40.
 - Rules 35, A4 and A5 will be changed to state, that boats failing to finish within 15 minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes will be scored Did Not Finish.
 - Part 5, Section B of The Racing Rules of Sailing, as well as rules 44.1 and 63.1 will be changed to permit Protest Arbitration.
 - Rule 60.1(a) will be changed to state, that a competitor cannot protest another boat or competitor for breaches of specific parts of the sailing instructions.
 - Rule 61.1(b) will be changed so protests by race committee and protest committee will be posted on the official notice board.
 - Rule 62.2 will be changed to shorten the time limit for a request for redress from a protest committee decision on the last scheduled day racing.
 - Rule A4 will be changed by stating, that a boat starting later than 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start.
- 1.5 If there is a conflict between languages the English text takes precedence.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The online official notice board is located at <https://www.manage2sail.com/da-DK/event/Melges24#!/>.
- 3.2 The race committee intends to broadcast race information regarding starts, courses etc. on VHF to the fleet. The VHF channel will be posted on the notice board.
[DP] While racing. From the first warning signal until the end of the last race of the day, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The regatta is open for all Melges 24 with a valid class certificate and all participants must be member of a national yacht club under World Sailing.
- 4.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the [Manage2sail](#) registration no later than Saturday the 08 Sept. of September 2021.
- 4.3 Later entries will be accepted until the day before the regatta start at an additional fee of 450 DKK.

5 FEE

- 5.1 The entry fee is DKK 1600 and covers participation in all racing activities for the regatta and pier beer for the entire boat crew after races.
- 5.2 The fee and payment for meals (see information in Addendum A) must be ordered and paid as part of the registration. The payment of fee and mechandize and services should be done on-line.

6 ADVERTISING

- 6.1 Boats are required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

7 SCHEDULE

- 7.1 Registration must be completed at the regatta office situated in the club house in the period:
- Thursday, October 06th at 17:00 to 20:00
 - Friday, October 08th at 08:00 to 9:00
- Boats who have not completed the registration within the mentioned period will be considered as "Did Not Compete" (DNC) until registration is complete.
- 7.2 Measurement (if any) and control will be performed Saturday, October 09th between the hours 17:00 and 21:00.

- Number of planned races is 18.
- 7.3 To achieve the best running of the regatta, race committee reserves the right to sail respectively fewer or more races than planned - a maximum of 7 on the same day. Any deviation in the number of races can not be grounds for a request for redress. This changes rule 62.1.
- 7.4 At the last day of racing no warning signal will be given later than 15:00.

8 VENUE

- 8.1 NoR Addendum 1 shows the plan of the event venue.
- 8.2 NoR Addendum 2 shows the location of the racing areas.

9 COURSES

- 9.1 The course will be an up / Down wind course with a target mark.
Target time is et to 45 min.

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 10.1 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

11 SCORING

- 11.1 A minimum of four (4) races must be completed to constitute a Danish Championship.
- 11.2
 - A. When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - B. When 5 races to 11 have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
 - C. When 11 races to 18 have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst two score.

12 SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS

- 12.1 [DP] Support person vessels shall be marked with club and national flag

13 BERTHING

- 13.1 Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the harbor.

14 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and in accordance with the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

15 DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS

- 15.1 Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around keelboats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the event.

16 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 16.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

17 INSURANCE

The boat is required to hold adequate third-party insurance, and it is the owner or owner's representative's sole and inescapable responsibility to ensure that the insurance is in place and is adequate.

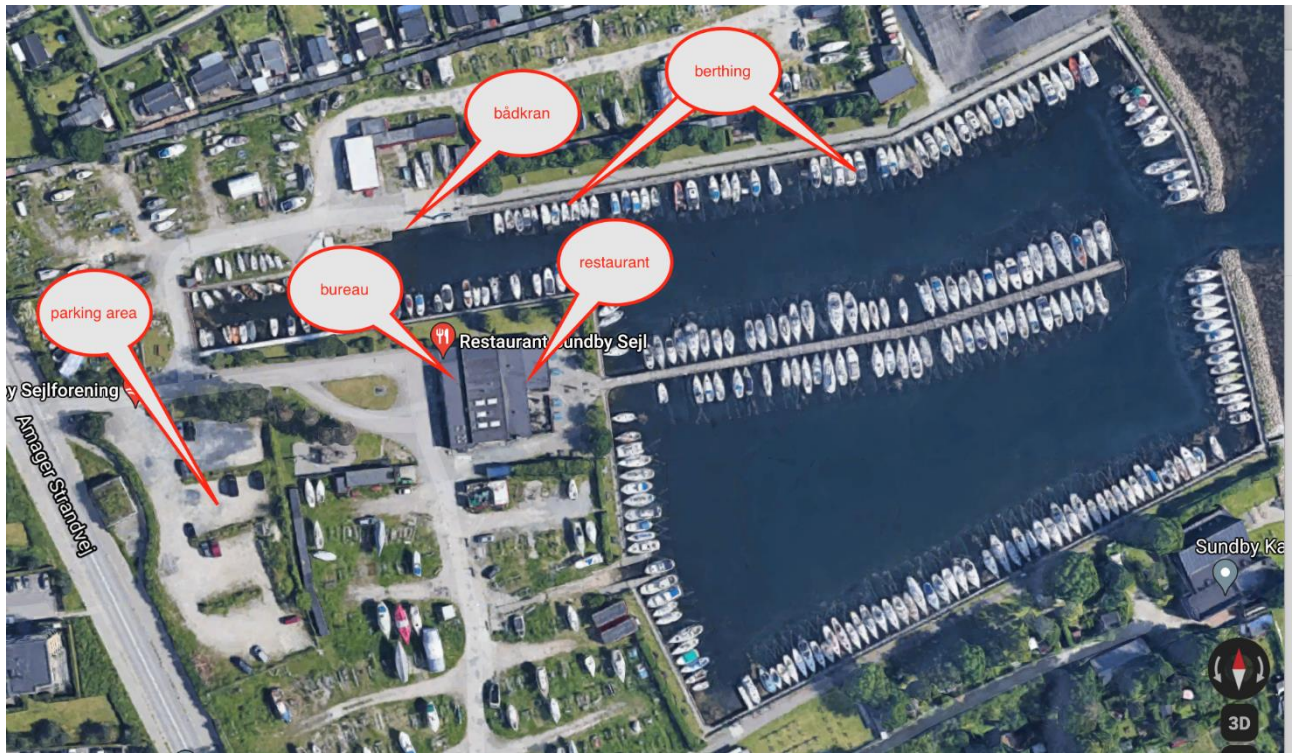

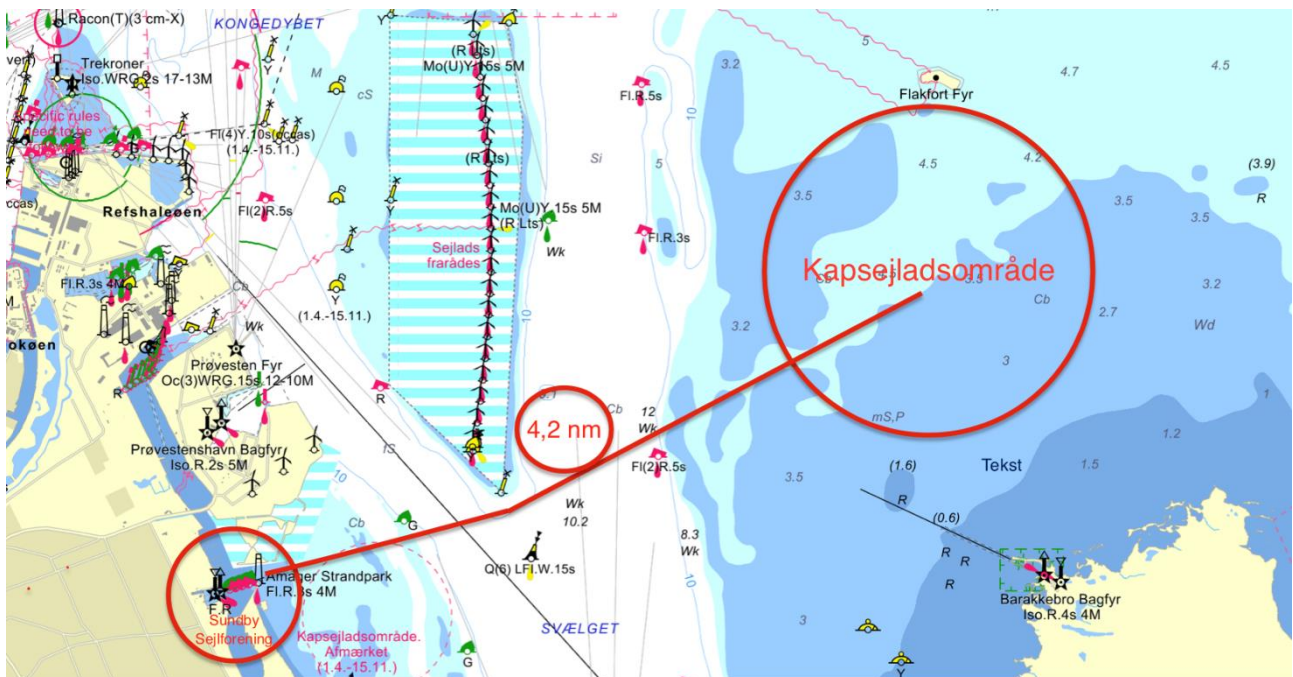
Venue



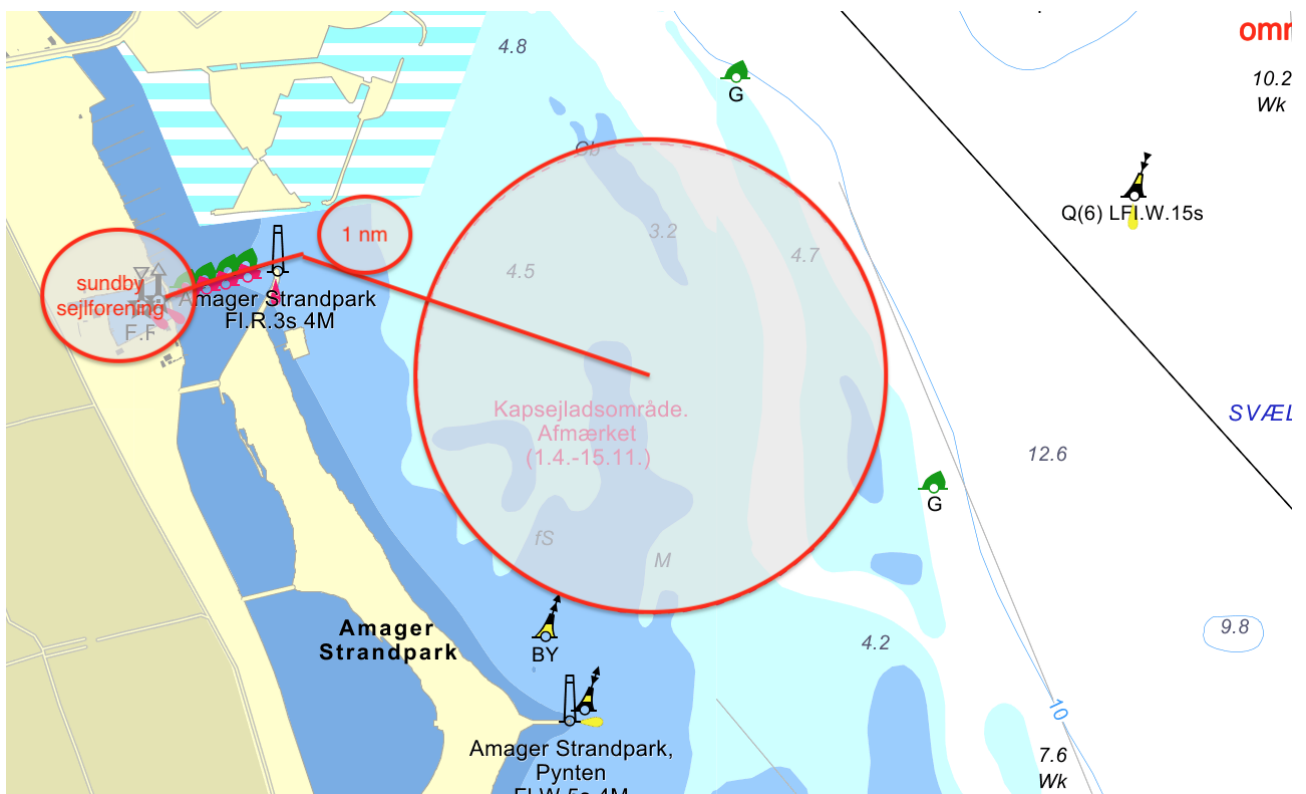
NoR Addendum 2.
