Welcome to Hankø

Hankø has been Norway's leading venue for international regattas for the last hundred years.
 Our cooperating club is Hankø Yacht Club (HYC).
 Senior members of KNS founded HYC in 1954 to attract international sailing at what they considered one of the best race courses in the world. The club has its picturesque clubhouse and a new protected harbor on the island a few hundred meters from the mainland. All championship participants will be guests of the HYC throughout the week.
 Participating boats will be moored along the berths just outside the clubhouse.

 Hankø is known to be a summer resort with private summer homes and the Hankø Hotel & Spa. Sailing has been an important activity and has made the island internationally well known. The island is located in the southeastern part of Norway at the Oslo Fjord, not far from the Swedish border.



Long traditions

- The Royal Norwegian Yacht Club has a long tradition of organizing regattas at Hankø. The first regatta took place in 1906. The Hankø Race Week is an annual keelboat event drawing both domestic and international participants.
- The racecourses at Hankø are perfect for international championships, for yachts ranging from ocean racers to smaller keelboats.
- Experienced race managers will organize the event, and the Principal Race Officer will be an International Race Officer. The International Jury will be appointed in cooperation with Melges 24.

We propose to organize this regatta at the same time as:


- Half Ton classics Cup

Harbor and sailing conditions

- Boats are berthed just in front of the Yacht Club.
- After a day on the fjord, we gather at the yacht club for refreshments and daily first-prize giving.
- The social program will be partly together with 11:meter and Half Ton at Hankø yacht Club and Hankø hotel.
- The sailing will occur just off the island in open water, where wind and sea conditions are very predictable. The sea breeze fills in in the afternoon, making it an excellent venue for sailing.
- In terms of weather, the average 24h for the last 10 years is 18 Celsius and 11 knots





Accomodation

- The Hankø Fjordhotell & Spa, with 230 beds, is within walking distance from Hankø Yacht Club (HYC). Hankø is known for many private summer homes. The housing committee will help find private accommodation if wanted, and many summer houses are available at Airbnb.
- The city of Fredrikstad is 10 20 minutes drive from Hankø and offers plenty of Hotell options in all price categories.
- HYC also has possibilities for accommodation, and it is a beautiful place to enjoy breakfast, even for those who are not staying at HYC.
- HYC will also offer lunch bags to the sailors and are the main venue for social gatherings



Transportation to Hankø

Boat transportation and traveling

- Coming from the continent by car: The roads through Sweden are well suited for trailing boats. Ferries are going from Kiel, Germany, and Frederikshavn, Denmark, to Oslo. Oslo – Hankø takes about one hour by car.
- Trailers and cars can be parked very close to the marina on the mainland.
- There will be sufficient crane capacity at the marina on the mainland close to HYC.
